

Getting to Know You

This exercise asks you to interview a fellow classmates. What you will do is pair up with a classmate, ask them some questions, and then introduce them to the class.

0.1 Step-by-Step Instructions

Step 1: Find a classmate (or two).

Step 2: Introduce yourself to the classmate

Step 3: Get to know this classmate.

1. What is their name, major, hometown, favorite class?
2. What do they do in their free time?
3. Why are you taking Symbolic Logic?
4. What is your earliest memory?
5. What is your most treasured possession?
6. If you could spend a day with anyone (living, dead, famous, otherwise), who would it be and why?
7. What is their favorite color, book, or movie?
8. What common interests do you share?
9. What is something they believe that people might find controversial?
10. What is their favorite place on campus?

Step 4: Present the person you interviewed to the class. Here is an example:

The person to my right is 'David W. Agler'. He is from Highland, IN but now lives in State College. He is a freshman majoring in Biology and is taking Symbolic Logic because he thought it sounded interesting. He enjoys distance running but hasn't been doing that lately because of an injury. In life, he would like to run in the Olympic Trials, have a family, and maybe work at a university. His prized possession is the blanket he's had since he was a baby. I found out that we both have a common interest in playing video games, specifically FIFA. We plan to play a few games after class.
